

Two Rivers Day Camp Confirmation and Daily Supply List

Your Girl Scout is registered for Day Camp July 30 – August 3, 2018.
Camp starts at 9:00 am and ends at 3:00 pm.



Please pick up your Girl Scout promptly either from camp or the bus stop. Remember, anyone she leaves with **MUST** be listed on her registration form, and you must sign out any girl you are picking up.

Here is a list of supplies your daughter will need to bring each day she attends Day Camp at Camp Elk River.

Please put your name on everything.

Remember, girls are responsible for carrying all their own gear all day.

- Back pack (to carry everything in)
- Water bottle (to help prevent dehydration)**
- Sweatshirt or sweater
- Rain gear
- Swim suit (Tuesday, Thursday & Friday)
- Towel (Tuesday, Thursday & Friday)
- Bag for wet suit (Tuesday, Thursday & Friday)
- Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- Chapstick with sunscreen
- Bandana
- Hat with brim or sunglasses
- Non-aerosol insect repellent
- Tie on shoes: No open toes or heels. No clog type shoes or crocs.**
- Socks
- Hair tie on Wednesday for cooking at the fire
- Sharpies on Friday for shirt signing
- In a zippered baggie in her back pack, please put your daughter's name, phone number, parent/guardian name(s) & phone number(s) as well as emergency contact name & phone number.

* Please note that siblings may not be in the same area & will be unable to share the same sunscreen & bug spray

For Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday:

- Bag lunch with a beverage**

For Wednesday:

- Wear your bathing suit to camp under your clothing & bring underclothing to change into. Also bring a 2nd (dry) pair of socks & shoes. Watershoes & crocs are ok to wear during the water event ONLY.**
- Dunk bag, including non-breakable (preferably re-usable plastic):**
 - **Plate** (A dunk bag is a nylon mesh bag with a drawstring or zipper container in which campers store their dishes after they wash them. These nylon bags can be found in the laundry sections at Target, Wal-mart, or Dollar Tree. They hang the bags to "drip dry".)
 - **Bowl**
 - **Cup**
 - **Fork**
 - **Spoon**

Please *DO NOT* bring or wear:

- Radios, cell phones or other electronic devices
- Jewelry or valuables
- Candy or gum
- Sandals or clogs
- Perfume or body sprays – we are fragrance free

Emergency Camp Evacuation:

In the event of an emergency camp evacuation, everyone will report to Timbermeade. The buses will arrive within 15 minutes. Adults who drove to camp may sign out their girls, take them and go. Everyone else will take the buses (even those who were dropped off).

Rivers Bend Service Unit girls & those who are riding the Oxbow Creek bus – Families will be called via cell phone on the way out of camp to pick up the girls at Oxbow Creek Elementary School. Staff will stay at Oxbow Creek Elementary until all girls are picked up.

Rum River Service Unit girls & anyone riding the Oak Grove City Hall bus - Families will be called via cell phone on the way out of camp to pick up the girls at Oak Grove City Hall. Staff will stay until all girls are picked up.

Everyone dropped off at camp who DOES NOT have their driver at camp that day will ride the Oak Grove City Hall bus & need to be picked up at Oak Grove City Hall.
